

Multimedia production “Nobody but a princess...” to be staged this week at Hong Kong Cultural Centre Piazza (with photos)

The multimedia production "Nobody but a princess...", featuring Nordic singers, dancers from the Hong Kong Ballet and overseas acrobats, will be staged in the evenings from Friday to Sunday (November 8 to 10) at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre Piazza. Members of the public are welcome to enjoy the performance with free admission.

Produced by the multimedia group phase7 performing.arts from Germany, the production is inspired by a fairy tale by Hans Christian Andersen and had its premiere at the H.C. Andersen Festivals 2018. "Nobody but a princess..." tells the story of a modern princess who discovers her identity and true love through her fantastic journey of wonders. The contemporary fairy tale will be staged in a custom-made giant dome, complete with a state-of-the-art kinetic light display and pyrotechnics.

Berlin-based phase7 performing.arts is best known for its thought-provoking integration of music, video and innovative technology. Formed in 1999, the group has since worked in many countries, including Dubai, France, Kuwait, Pakistan, Spain and Norway, and its large-scale multimedia productions such as "Words All Over", "Traces" and "DELUSIONS II" have received critical acclaim.

"Nobody but a princess...", presented by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, is a special outdoor event in support of the World Cultures Festival 2019 – The Nordics. The programme will be held at 6pm, 7pm and 8.30pm every evening from November 8 to 10 at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre Piazza. The programme will be conducted in English and will include a strobe light effect.
