- provide training for managers

The team worked hard to put this action plan into practice. We gained <u>external accreditation</u> for our commitment and had positive feedback from our colleagues. Employee absence rates have reduced since the implementation of this action plan.

We're so proud to have been shortlisted for this award. We'll continue to work hard to provide the best possible working environment for our colleagues.
