## News story: Line-side workers near miss, Dutton Viaduct

Near miss between a train and line-side workers on Dutton Viaduct, between Crewe and Runcorn, Cheshire, 18 September 2017.

At around 16:57 hrs on Monday 18th September 2017, a passenger train travelling at 125 mph (200 km/h), encountered three line-side workers on Dutton Viaduct. The workers managed to move clear of the track less than  $\frac{1}{2}$  second before the train passed them. No injuries were caused to the workers, but the train driver was shaken by the incident.

We have undertaken a <u>preliminary examination</u> into the circumstances surrounding this incident. Having assessed the evidence which has been gathered to date, we have decided to publish a <u>safety digest</u>.
