

Nominations for Best Landscape Award for Private Property Development 2022 extended to July 20

The Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) announced today (April 15) that the nominations for the Best Landscape Award for Private Property Development 2022 will be extended to July 20. Application is free of charge.

The award aims to commend private property developments that excel in landscape design and horticultural maintenance. It also aims to bring about sustained environmental improvements in private property developments and encourage private bodies to incorporate more quality green elements into the planning and management of horticultural projects for the benefit of such developments.

The award is presented in five categories. Each category is divided into three groups according to the age of the property. Nominations by email are accepted for the award this year.
