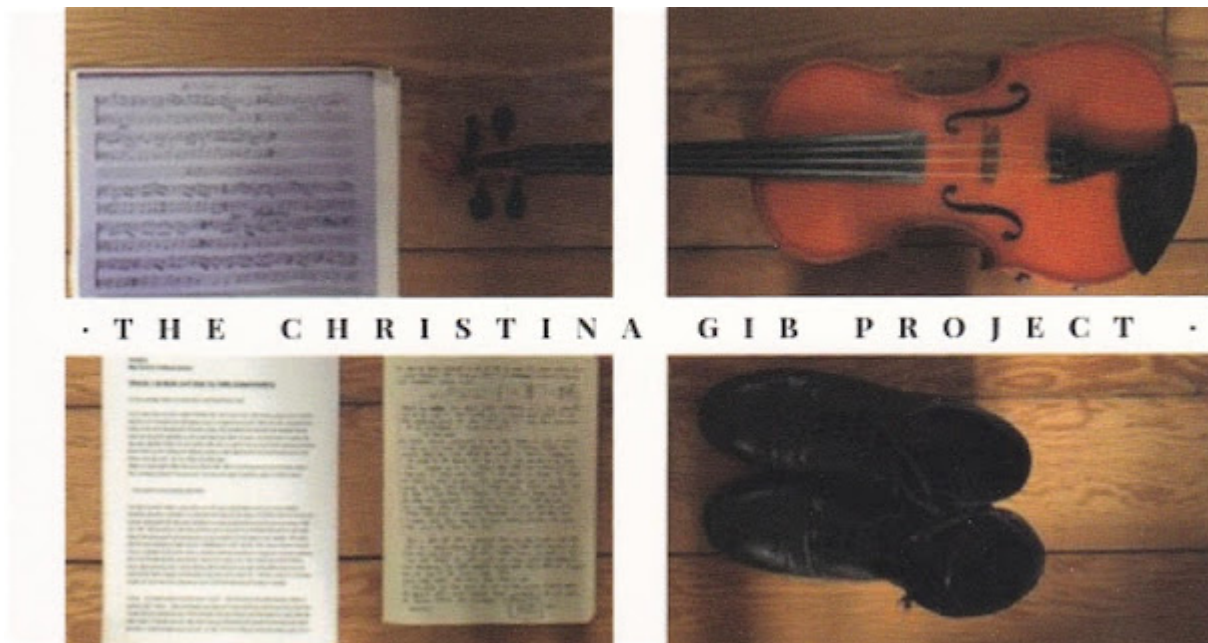


[Christina – A New Folk Performance](#) [#dundeewestend](#)
