REPORT FOR THE WEST END WARD – WEEK COMMENCING MONDAY 18 JULY 2022

South Tay Street – temporary traffic lights for 4 weeks for footway works.

Miller's Wynd – closed at its junction with Hawkhill for major construction works. Start date Monday 27 June for 6 months.

City Road at Baxter Street – 3-way temporary traffic lights from Wednesday 21 July for 3 days for CityFibre works.

Blackness Road (at Peddie Street) – temporary traffic lights Thursday 7 July for 10 days for Scotland Gas Network work.

Hawkhill at Session Street – lane closures from Monday 25 July for 5 days for CityFibre works.

Easson's Angle – closed from Monday 18 July for 5 days for CityFibre Works.

West Marketgait – lane closure from Monday 18 July for 5 days for CityFibre works.
