

Over 2 600 quality job vacancies to be offered at Seizing New Opportunities Job Fair

The Labour Department (LD) will hold the Seizing New Opportunities Job Fair at Dragon Centre in Sham Shui Po on November 8 and 9 to provide a large number of vacancies from various industries for job seekers.

About 40 organisations will participate in the two-day job fair, offering over 2 600 quality job vacancies from various industries. Around 20 organisations will set up booths and conduct recruitment on the spot each day. A wide variety of positions will be offered including engineer, accountant, pastry cook, tailor, bartender, programmer, clerk, kitchen helper, security officer, e-commerce assistant, and warehouse assistant. Around 89 per cent of the vacancies offered at the job fair are full-time jobs. Most vacancies offer monthly salaries ranging from \$13,000 to \$21,000. About 94 per cent of the vacancies require a Secondary Five education level or below. Around 69 per cent are open to job seekers without relevant work experience.

Job seekers can submit job applications during the event and may be selected for on-the-spot interviews. They can also make enquiries on the employment services provided by the LD at its counter inside the venue.

The job fair will be held from 11am to 5.30pm at Atrium, 1/F, Dragon Centre, 37 K Yen Chow Street, Sham Shui Po (near Sham Shui Po MTR Station Exit C1). Admission is free, with final admission time at 5pm each day.
