Press release - COVID-19: debate on developing countries' access to vaccines



Date: Thursday, 4 February, 9:30-10:30

MEPs are expected to urge the Commission to help make vaccines available to developing countries and will be asked to explain how this can be achieved.

Background

In an <u>upcoming draft report</u>, the committee is set to ask for substantial new funds to assist developing countries worldwide in their fight against COVID-19, including by making vaccines available globally. Last spring, Development Committee Chair <u>Tomas Tobé</u> (EPP, SE) <u>called for such action</u>, and the committee urged the international community to <u>protect the most vulnerable</u>.

In a debate in November 2020, the GAVI vaccine alliance told the committee they planned to deliver <u>two billion doses of safe</u>, <u>effective COVID-19</u> <u>vaccines</u> by 2021.
