<u>Press release — MEPs approve €585</u> <u>million to support refugees from Syria</u>



The <u>draft report</u> by <u>Monika Hohlmeier</u> (EPP, DE) recommending the approval of the <u>draft amending budget</u> was adopted on Wednesday with 33 votes to 4 and 3 abstentions.

€485 million are earmarked to fund the continuation of the two main EU humanitarian support actions in Turkey, the <u>Emergency Social Safety Net</u> (ESSN) and the Conditional Cash Transfer for Education (CCTE).

Host communities and refugees (Syrian refugees and Palestinian refugees from Syria) in Jordan and Lebanon are supported with a total of €100 million. This money will be used to fund projects giving access to education, to support livelihoods and for the provision of health, sanitation, water and waste services, as well as social protection.
