## Press release - MEPs approve €585 million to support Syrian refugees in neighbouring countries



The <u>report</u> by <u>Monika Hohlmeier</u> (EPP, DE) recommending the approval of the <u>draft amending budget</u> was adopted on Friday with 557 votes to 72 and 59 abstentions.

€485 million have been earmarked to keep funding the two main EU humanitarian support actions in Turkey, the <a href="Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN)">Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN)</a> and the <a href="Conditional Cash Transfer for Education">CONDITIONAL CASH Transfer for Education</a> (CCTE).

Host communities and refugees (Syrian refugees and Palestinian refugees from Syria) in Jordan and Lebanon will be supported with a total of €100 million. This money will be used to fund projects that offer access to education, support livelihoods and provide health, sanitation, water and waste services, as well as social protection.
