<u>Press release: Scottish Secretary</u> <u>responds to First Minister Nicola</u> <u>Sturgeon's statement</u>

Following today's [Wednesday 24 April] statement in Holyrood from the First Minister Nicola Sturgeon, Scottish Secretary David Mundell said:
