Assistant Secretary of State for Energy Resources Francis R. Fannon will travel to Miami, Florida and Lima, Peru from March 31 to April 4, 2019.

In Miami, Assistant Secretary Fannon will speak at the opening session of the World Strategic Forum hosted by the International Economic Forum of the Americas. At the conference he will also meet with energy sector leaders and experts to discuss U.S. global energy engagement.

In Peru, Assistant Secretary Fannon will meet with senior government officials and energy sector business leaders. He will also visit the Cerro Verde mining operation in Arequipa.
