

Proposed amendments to road works at Kennedy Road, Queen's Road East and Ship Street gazetted

The Government gazetted today (July 12) the proposed amendments to road works at Kennedy Road, Queen's Road East and Ship Street in Wan Chai to revise the design and alignment of sections of the roads.

Any person who wishes to object to the proposed amendments is required to address to the Secretary for Transport and Housing an objection in writing, which can be submitted via the following means:

A notice of objection should describe the objector's interest and the manner in which he or she alleges that they will be affected by the proposed amendments.
