

# Proposed amendments to road works at Tung Chung New Town Extension (East) gazetted

The Government gazetted today (December 10) the proposed amendments to the road works at Tung Chung East and Road P1 (Tung Chung East to Tai Ho Section) under the Tung Chung New Town Extension project to introduce underground cycle subways.
