

# Public engagement on cycle track section between Tsuen Wan Bayview Garden and So Kwun Wat launched

The Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD) today (October 3) launched a two-month public engagement for the cycle track section between Tsuen Wan Bayview Garden and So Kwun Wat.

The approximately 17-kilometre-long Tsuen Wan Bayview Garden and So Kwun Wat section is part of the New Territories Cycle Track Network. With a total length of about 82km, the New Territories Cycle Track Network runs from the east to the west of the New Territories, providing the public with a leisure and recreational option. The CEDD seeks to collect views from the public on this section through the public engagement before proceeding with the works.

A roving exhibition, a co-design workshop and virtual reality bike experiences will be held during the public engagement period to help people learn more about the cycle track section.
