## <u>Relief fund for farmers and fishermen</u> <u>affected by Super Typhoon Mangkhut</u> <u>(with photos)</u>

Local farmers and fishermen who suffered serious losses caused by Super Typhoon Mangkhut can register with the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) from tomorrow (September 19) to September 28 for assistance from an emergency relief fund.

An AFCD spokesman said today (September 18) that an appropriate amount of the relief fund would be released for the affected farmers and fishermen according to established criteria.

The department's preliminary investigation has revealed that farmland in the New Territories, fish rafts and fish ponds in all districts and some fishing vessels suffered different levels of damage, some of which was severe.

"After each typhoon or natural disaster, the AFCD staff will contact farmers and fishermen to learn the situation regarding their farmland, fish rafts, fish ponds and fishing vessels to assess the damage situation," the spokesman said.

"Depending on the gravity of the damage, we may launch an operation to provide some relief to affected farmers and fishermen."
