

Reprovisioning of Yau Ma Tei Public Library completed (with photos)

The Leisure and Cultural Services Department announced today (February 18) that Yau Ma Tei Public Library (YMTPL) has been reprovisioned at Block A, G/F & 1-3/F, 251 Shanghai Street, and will be open tomorrow (February 19). The old YMTPL, located at G/F & M/F, 250 Shanghai Street, has already ceased operation.

The floor area of the reprovisioned YMTPL has been expanded from about 1 580 square metres to some 2 300 sq m, and YMTPL is provided with up-to-date facilities and services such as a Computer and Information Centre and a Multimedia Library, offering residents more diversified library services and a pleasant reading environment.

In view of the latest situation of COVID-19, YMTPL will open the Adult Library and the Children's Library, offering lending and returning of library materials and collection of reserved items, while other facilities will remain closed.
