Review of objections to 2020-21 rateable values completed

The Rating and Valuation Department has completed its review of more than 63 000 objections received from March 16 to May 31 in regard to the new rateable values in the Valuation List and Government Rent Roll. Notices of Decision (Form R22A) in respect of these objections have been issued in phases by the department.

A spokesman for the department today (November 20) said that anyone who lodged an objection during this period and who has not yet received a Notice of Decision should contact the department's Customer Service Officer, Mr Brian Ng, on 2150 8902.

The spokesman said that any alterations in rateable values as a result of the objections would take effect retrospectively from April 1 this year, and adjustments to the amount of rates and Government rent payable would be made in subsequent demand notes.
