The meadows, woods and marshy ground in the Nature Park are full of colour at the moment with over 150 species of flowering plant recorded so far. Greater Yellow Rattle, introduced under licence, is flowering for the first time as we establish Scotland's third population of this rare plant. Bees, Butterflies and hosts of other insects take advantage of all this bounty. Birds like Skylark, Yellowhammer, Reed Bunting, Whitethroat and Bullfinch are breeding. Join us for a walk around the park with a local expert to look and enjoy all this wildlife.
