

SB responds to media enquiries on S for S' health condition

In response to media enquiries on the health condition of the Secretary for Security, Mr John Lee, a spokesman for the Security Bureau said today (March 25) that after receiving the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, Mr Lee did not experience any adverse reaction or discomfort.
