## SCED to attend ASEAN Economic Ministers — Hong Kong, China Consultation meeting in Laos

The Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, Mr Algernon Yau, will depart for Vientiane, Laos, tomorrow (September 19) to attend the eighth Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) Economic Ministers — Hong Kong, China (HKC) Consultation meeting to be held on September 20.
