<u>Service arrangements for Public</u> <u>Records Office of Government Records</u> <u>Service</u>

In line with the extension of the special work arrangements announced by the Government, the Government Records Service (GRS) today (August 14) announced that from August 17 to 23, the Search Room of the Public Records Office (PRO) will only open on Wednesday (August 19) from 9am to 1pm for users who have made a reservation for holdings through the online catalogue. The quota is four users, and it will be allocated on a first-come, firstserved basis. Public services will be limited to:

Loan and circulation service for reserved holdings; and
Self-service reproduction of holdings.

The above services will be suspended for those who have not made an online reservation for holdings. Meanwhile, users are required to wear masks at all times when they are inside the Hong Kong Public Records Building, and follow the infection control measures implemented by the GRS including temperature checks upon entering the building and applying hand sanitiser.

The Exhibition Hall in the Hong Kong Public Records Building will continue to be closed. Visits and public education programmes are suspended until further notice.
