The preliminary positive case in the Old Age Living Allowance Centralised Team is related to a Clerical Assistant, who last performed duties on February 15, while the preliminary positive case in the Shek Kip Mei Social Security Field Unit is related to a Workman II who last performed duties on February 16. They had been wearing masks when performing duties. Their body temperatures were normal when undergoing temperature screening during work.
