

## Several SWD offices temporarily closed

The Social Welfare Department (SWD) today (February 21) said that several offices will be temporarily closed until further notice due to the occurrences of positive, preliminary positive and suspected cases of COVID-19 respectively. The details are set out as below:

On the positive cases, the case found in the Chai Wan Social Security Field Unit is related to a Social Security Assistant, who last performed duties on February 18. The one in the Ma On Shan (North) Integrated Family Service Centre is related to a Workman II, who last performed duties on February 16, while the case found in the Tsing Yi (South) Integrated Family Service Centre is related to a Social Work Assistant, who last performed duties on February 16.

On the preliminary positive cases, the case found in the Fanling Integrated Family Service Centre is related to an Assistant Clerical Officer, who last performed duties on February 17, while the case found in the To Kwa Wan Integrated Family Service Centre is related to a Part-time Contract Welfare Support and Liaison Assistant, who last performed duties on February 16.

They had been wearing masks when performing duties. Their body temperatures were normal when undergoing temperature screening during work.
