This document covers charges for activities that require a permit or registered exemption from the Environment Agency under Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016.

- flood risk activities
- installations
- waste operations
- mining waste operations
- mobile plant
- land spreading
- water discharge activities
- groundwater activities
- radioactive substances activities
- exempt waste operations
