<u>SWD Assistant Clerical Officer tests</u> preliminarily positive for COVID-19

The Social Welfare Department (SWD) today (February 15) said that an Assistant Clerical Officer of the Sha Tin (South) Integrated Family Service Centre has tested preliminarily positive for COVID-19.

The staff member had no contact with members of the public in her daily work. She worked on the 8/F of the Sha Tin Government Offices and last performed duties on February 10. She had been wearing a mask when performing duties. Her body temperature was normal when undergoing temperature screening during work.

A thorough cleaning and disinfection has been arranged at the premises concerned. All staff of the same floor will undergo COVID-19 testing and work from home while waiting for the results. The SWD will maintain close contact with the Centre for Health Protection of the Department of Health to take follow-up action as appropriate. The SWD service units on the 8/F of the Sha Tin Government Offices (including service counters) will be closed temporarily. Reopening arrangements will be announced later.
