

Guidance: Bluetongue: how to spot and report it

The latest bluetongue situation, how to spot it, report it and prevent it spreading.

Statutory guidance: Bluetongue: licence to move animals from a premises within a temporary control zone (TCZ) to another premises within the same TCZ during the seasonally vector low period (EXD585(E))

This licence allows you to move animals between premises in the same TCZ during the seasonally vector low period.

Statutory guidance: Bluetongue: licence to move animals from a premises within a temporary control zone (TCZ) to an abattoir within the same TCZ for slaughter during the seasonally vector low period (EXD584(E))

This licence allows you to move animals from a premises to an abattoir in the same TCZ for slaughter during the seasonally vector low period.

Form: Bluetongue: apply for a specific movement licence

Apply for a specific licence to move animals in, out or within in a bluetongue disease control zone.
