Research and analysis: Displacement and habituation of seabirds in response to marine activities (MMO 1139)

This report provides a high-level overview of current knowledge of habituation of seabirds to disturbance impacts associated with anthropogenic marine activities in English territorial waters and subsequent habituation to those activities.

The report explores whether habituation is species or activity dependent and informs on the conditions and scales under which disturbance, displacement, habituation and attraction does or does not occur.

<u>Independent report: Multi-Agency Flood</u> <u>Plan (MAFP) review</u>

This final report sets out the findings of the Multi-Agency Flood Plan review.

The review looked at:

- the effectiveness and consistency of current flood plans produced by Local Resilience Forums (LRFs) in England
