Form: Coal Authority Evaluation Licence

This licence applies to data supplied for commercial evaluation and development purposes.

Guidance: Available Coal Authority

data sets

'Use' means the use of Coal Authority data by persons or legal entities 'for commercial or non-commercial purposes within the public task for which the documents were produced'. Where available, data sets which are licenced for use will contain personal data.

'Re-use' means the use of Coal Authority data by persons or legal entities 'for commercial or non-commercial purposes other than the initial purpose within the public task for which the documents were produced' (as defined by the European Directive on the Re-Use of Public Sector Information 2015).

Data sets which are licenced for reuse will have all personal data removed.

Form: Coal Authority Internal Data Re-Use Licence

This licence applies to data supplied to businesses for internal purposes such as mining hazard and risk analysis, site investigations, asset management and hydrocarbon exploration companies
