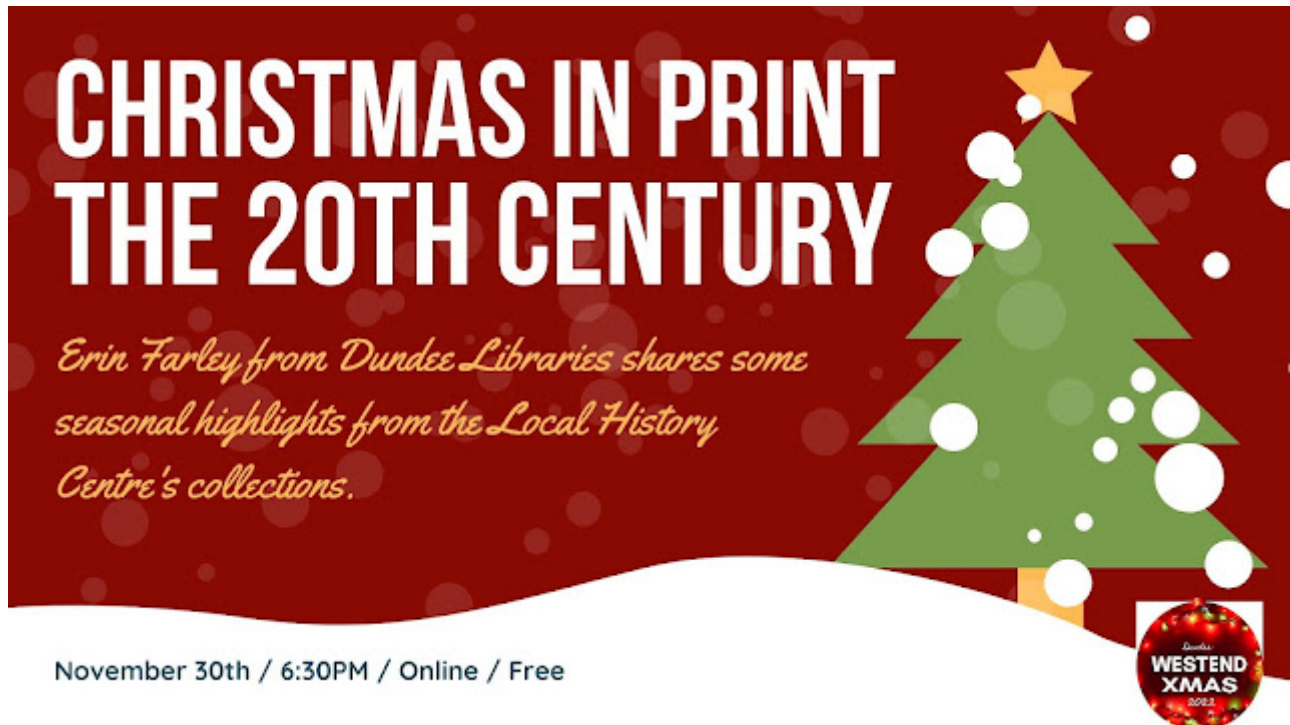


Christmas in Print – the twentieth century #dundeewestend
