Easter eggventure – 9th April

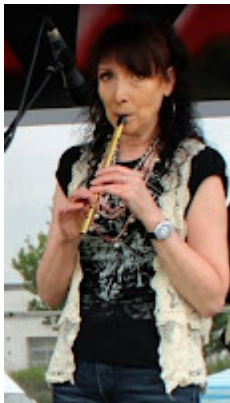
