South Tay Street – temporary traffic lights for 3 weeks for footway works.

Miller's Wynd – closed at its junction with Hawkhill for major construction works. Start date Monday 27 June for 6 months.

City Road at Baxter Street – 3-way temporary traffic lights from Monday 4 July for 3 days for CityFibre works.

Thomson Street (Seafield Lane for 50m south) – closed Wednesday 6 July for one week for Scottish Water work.

Milnbank Road at Bankmill Road – 2-way temporary traffic lights from Thursday 7 July for 3 days for CityFibre works.
