

Temporary closure of Hennessy Road Post Office and Fu Shan Post Office

Hongkong Post said today (February 23) that due to a postal staff member has tested preliminarily positive for COVID-19, Hennessy Road Post Office is closed from today (February 23) until February 25.

The postal staff member works at the counter behind a partition to keep an appropriate social distance from customers. He underwent temperature screening when attending work and his body temperature was normal. He was wearing a mask while on duty.

Upon notification of the case, Hongkong Post arranged for all postal staff members concerned to undergo COVID-19 testing and thorough cleaning and disinfection of all the facilities and mail items of the premises pursuant to the guidelines set out by the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health (DH).

Besides, Fu Shan Post Office will be closed from tomorrow (February 24) until February 26 as it is located at Fu Shun House in Fu Shan Estate, which is included in a compulsory testing notice.
