

# Temporary closure of some post offices

Hongkong Post said today (March 14) that as some postal staff members have been confirmed as having COVID-19, Sheung Wan Post Office, Happy Valley Post Office, Hing Man Street Post Office, Shau Kei Wan Post Office, Wah Fu Post Office, Stanley Post Office, Sham Shui Po Post Office, Tuen Mun Central Post Office, City One Shatin Post Office, Wah Ming Post Office, Choi Ming Post Office, Tseung Kwan O Post Office, Tung Chung Post Office and Cheung Chau Post Office are closed today for thorough cleaning and disinfection of all the facilities and mail items of the premises pursuant to the guidelines set out by the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health (DH).

The postal staff members concerned underwent temperature screening when attending work and their body temperature was normal. They were wearing masks while on duty.

Upon notification of the cases, Hongkong Post arranged for all postal staff members concerned to undergo COVID-19 testing.
