

# Temporary closure of some post offices

Hongkong Post said today (March 1) that as some postal staff members have received positive results when undergoing COVID-19 rapid antigen tests, Tuen Mun Central Post Office is closed until March 2 and its Post Office Box Lobby will be reopened tomorrow (March 2). Wah Fu Post Office, Kwai Fong Post Office, Lam Tin Post Office and To Kwa Wan Post Office (including the Post Office Box Lobby) are closed until March 3. Besides, Bulk Acceptance Office of Air Mail Centre is closed until March 2.

The postal staff members concerned underwent temperature screening when attending work and their body temperature was normal. They were wearing masks while on duty.

Upon notification of the cases, Hongkong Post arranged for all postal staff members concerned to undergo COVID-19 testing and thorough cleaning and disinfection of all the facilities and mail items of the premises pursuant to the guidelines set out by the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) of the Department of Health (DH).
