

Temporary suspension of LCSD's Mobile Library 1, 6, 8 and 12 services

The affected service points are Choi Ying Estate in Kowloon Bay, Laguna City in Lam Tin, Hiu Lai Court and Po Tat Estate in Sau Mau Ping, Yau Lai Estate in Yau Tong, Tai Hang Tung Estate on Tai Hang Tung Road and Laguna Verde in Hung Hom. Mobile Library 6 will suspend services from May 23 to 28. The affected service points are Shau Kei Wan Market in Shau Kei Wan Main Street East, Lei Tung Estate and Ap Lei Chau Estate in Ap Lei Chau, the First Aid Station at Shek O Beach and Tsui Lam Estate in Tseung Kwan O.
