"The new figures from

the NMC expose the Government's hollow promises on nurse recruitment. Far from

delivering the staff needed to keep patients on wards safe, nurse numbers are now in fact falling in our NHS. It's

staggering that numbers are falling when all the evidence shows we need more nurses in the NHS, not less.

"The truth is that the

Government has totally failed in its planning of the NHS workforce. The disastrous pay cap has pushed staff to the brink and the end of bursaries has led to a fall in places on nursing degrees. Now Theresa May's chaotic approach

to Brexit is directly impacting staffing levels in the NHS.

"With winter coming it is

essential the NHS can get enough staff in place to deliver safe services for patients. The Government needs to get a grip and come up with a sustainable long term plan for the NHS which deals with the staffing crisis and gives the NHS the funding it needs."
