<u>Update on MiFID II registers from 3</u> <u>January 2018</u>

ESMA is currently working on a new release of those registers for Q1 2018. Therefore, until the new register release is fully available as an IT functionality on our website, ESMA will provide an interim solution which involves it publishing, on a fortnightly basis, the latest registers information in an <u>excel format</u> which will be available for download. The list of affected registers is as follows:

- Regulated markets
- Multilateral Trading Facilities
- NEW Organised trading facilities
- Systematic Internalisers
- NEW Approved Publication Arrangements
- NEW Consolidated Tape Providers
- NEW Approved Reporting Mechanisms
- Suspension and Restorations (SARIS)*

ESMA will continue to monitor the data submitted to the registers and may make the files available, outside of the fortnightly schedule, should the requirement arise. ESMA encourages market participants to review the data provided and contact their National Competent Authority in case of any data discrepancy.
