

Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency staff member tests preliminarily positive for COVID-19

The Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency (WFSFAA) said today (February 17) that a clerical staff member in its Office of the Continuing Education Fund (CEF) tested preliminarily positive for COVID-19.

The staff member works on 25/F, CDW Building, Tsuen Wan. She had no contact with the public in her daily work and last went to work on February 15. She had been wearing a mask at work and followed relevant disease prevention measures.

The WFSFAA will arrange thorough cleaning and disinfection for the premises concerned. All staff working on the same floor will undergo COVID-19 testing and will work from home while waiting for the results. The WFSFAA will maintain close liaison with the Centre for Health Protection of the Department of Health in taking appropriate follow-up action.
